Whereas in order to ensure the implementation of the guidelines of Ministry of Home Affairs and in order to facilitate the availability of vegetables and other agricultural produce in Assam, the undersigned in exercise of the powers conferred under section 22(2)(h) of Disaster Management Act 2005, in his capacity as Chairperson State Executive Committee hereby issues directions to all the Deputy Commissioners of Assam to ensure that

- i) The unhindered inter-district movement of agricultural produce is permitted.
- ii) No district shall stop the movement of vehicles carrying vegetables and agricultural produce.
- iii) Entry and exit of such vehicles in the containment zones shall be followed as per advise and guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs and State Health Department.
