### MEMORANDUM

Sub. Banners and Posters to be displayed in all Govt. Offices and public places Ref. No: -50-17/COLL(N)/DMC/ Aware-COVID-19/2020-21/1352 dated 12/11/2020

With reference to the above and due to a steep rise in Covid Cases in the State of Goa, there is a need to reactivate a public awareness campaign to influence public behavior on wearing masks, social distancing and maintaining hand hygiene. Further, there is also a need to create public awareness on the ongoing Covid vaccination drive being conducted by the Government.

In view of the above, you are required to display banners /posters at entry gates of your Head/ Sub Offices for creating awareness on Covid and also on Covid vaccinations (copies enclosed). Further, the persons who are vaccinated from various departments, if any, may share their experience and encourage their fellow colleagues and staff on the importance of vaccination to curtail the spread of this contagious virus.

The above directions are to be conveyed to all officials of your departments and banners/posters in public areas under your jurisdiction for effective implementation inorder to curb the spread of the pandemic, under intimation to this office. Also, Covid appropriate behavior i.e. wearing masks, social distancing and maintaining hand hygiene and guidelines issued by the MHA from time to time and shall be strictly followed at all Government Departments and offices and public areas under your jurisdiction. Violations, if any, shall be viewed strictly and action taken accordingly.


Protect yourself and others by getting the COVID-19 vaccine when it is your turn






Getting vaccinated can help prevent getting sick with COVID-19.

COVID-19 vaccines do not change or interact with your DNA in any way.




There is currently no evidence that COVID-19 vaccines cause any problems with pregnancy or fertility.

Vaccinated people are probably less likely to transmit COVID-19


Enough vaccinated people can reduce the spread.

Millions of people have been vaccinated. Reports of serious side effects have been very rare and no long term complications reported.






Seek facts, backed by research and data, published by credible health care providers and organisations. Avoid spreading misinformation.




