The Government of Goa is pleased to make the following Scheme and is hereby published for general information of public, which shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

- 1. Short title and commencement— This Scheme may be called 'Covid-19 Relief to Marginalized/Unorganised Sector'. The Scheme shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette of Goa Government and shall be implemented through Directorate of Social Welfare, Government of Goa.
 - 2. Objectives.— The objectives of the Scheme are as follows:
 - Primarily to provide a one time financial relief to a large number of people engaged in different marginalized/unorganized sectors, whose livelihood/source of income has been interrupted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - > Help such people to tide through the difficult phase and recover from the financial impact caused by the pandemic.
 - 3. Target group and eligibility.—

Target Group:— (i) The Scheme shall be applicable to all those people who are engaged in traditional occupations and traditional business of Goa and occupations of resident Goans mostly informal and largely unorganized sector of Goa's economy, which have proven operational/production/marketing history before liberation of Goa (1961) as testified by the local people/knowledgeable local experts and where available, supported by published documents/product samples/ethnographic/museum displays Schedule (A).

- (ii) Besides this, target group also include the pilot of Motorcycle and Auto Rickshaw pilot who were affected on account of Covid-19 pandemic Schedule (B).
- (iii) Further, the target also includes certain categories of occupations as mentioned in Schedule (C) for the benefit of the scheme due to their loss of income on account of Covid -19 pandemic.
- (iv) The target group also include the occupations as mentioned in Schedule (D) due to their loss of income on account of Covid 19 pandemic.
- 4. Eligibility & documents required.— All applicants, for availing benefits under this Scheme, shall provide the following documents:
 - (a) Attested or self attested copy of Electoral Photo Identity Card issued by authorities in Goa.
 - (b) Attested or self attested copy of Aadhar Card.
 - (c) Attested or self attested copy of Bank passbook.
 - (d) Verification & Recommendation by the Office of Panchayat Secretary/Officer designated by the Municipal Council/Corporation of City of Panaji, as in Annexure-I.

- 5. For establishing the applicant's engagement in the relevant trade, the following eligibility criteria will apply for the applicant who belongs to Schedule-A:
 - a. Attested or self attested copy of License or Registration or valid Permit issued by competent authority, pertaining to their marginalized/unorganized trade OR
 - b. A copy of certificate from a registered association of the trade, as per format given in Annexure - II
- 5.1 For establishing the applicant's engagement in the relevant trade, for an applicant who belongs to Schedule-B, following eligibility criteria will apply:
 - a. Attested or self attested copy of Badge and License or Registration or valid Permit issued by competent authority, pertaining to their marginalized/unorganized trade OR
 - b. A copy of certificate from a registered association of the trade, as per format given in Annexure II
- 5.2 For establishing the applicant's engagement in the relevant trade, for an applicant who belongs to Schedule-C, following eligibility criteria will apply:
 - a. Attested or self attested copy of Badge and copy of License or Registration or valid Permit issued by competent authority, pertaining to their marginalized/unorganized trade and certificate as per format at Annexure-III
- 5.3 For establishing the applicant's engagement in the relevant trade, for an applicant who belongs to Schedule-D, following eligibility criteria will apply:
 - a. Attested or self attested copy of Badge issued by competent authority, pertaining to their marginalized/unorganized trade.

This scheme shall not be applicable to those employed in:

- a. Government, Government funded organisations, statutory organisations, Central Government & its organisations.
- b. Private organisations including Companies, Partnerships, Associations of Persons, Body of Individuals, Trusts, Co-operative Societies and the likes.
- 6. Benefits.— An amount of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) shall be granted to the eligible applicant as a one time relief and the same will be transferred directly to the bank account of the beneficiary.
- 7. Mode of application.— The application for availing the benefits under the Scheme, shall be made in a prescribed form by Directorate of Social Welfare and shall be submitted to the concerned Panchayat Secretary/Chief Officer of Municipality or Officer designated by the Municipal Council/Corporation of City of Panaji.

The Panchayat Secretary/Officer designated by the Municipal Council/Corporation of City of Panaji shall verify and forward the application received by them from the applicant so as to reach the Directorate of Social Welfare, Panaji, within 10 days from the receipt of the same.

- 8. Scrutiny of application.— A committee comprising of the following members will scrutinize all the applications received within 15 days.
 - 9. Scrutiny Committee.— The Committee shall consist of the following:

Chairman

District Welfare Officer(N)

Member Secretary

Asst Accounts Officer, Social Welfare

- 10. Sanctioning.— Based on the report of the Scrutiny Committee, the Director, Social Welfare shall sanction the applications within 15 days.
- 11. Disbursement.— The Director, Social Welfare, shall within 8 days of sanctioning an application, refer the bills to the Directorate of Accounts for disbursement directly to the bank account of the beneficiary.
- 12. Classification of Marginalized/Unorganized Sector.— The classification of Marginalized/Unorganized Sector Occupations shall be done as per Schedule-A, Schedule-B, Schedule-C & Schedule-D.
- 13. Interpretation of Scheme.— Secretary, Social Welfare, shall be the final authority concerning the interpretation of the scheme.
 - 14. Relaxation of the Scheme.
 - a. The Government may relax any or all the conditions under this scheme.
 - b. The Government shall have full power to add occupations or change the classification of Marginalized/Unorganized Sector Occupations.
