Administrative Departments may allow Corporations/ Agencies/ PSUs under their administrative control, engaged in handling essential goods & services and other critical activities like mining, agriculture procurement, industrial development, forest plantation and maintenance, procurement of minor forest produce, beverages etc., to operate at 100% capacity.

All the employees of Government in the State, who are not attending office, will work from home. This order will be effective from 04th May, 2020 till 17th May, 2020.
